

Interdisciplinary Digitization Research Cartography - Europe

The selection of the listed research institutions of interdisciplinary digitalization research was based on the following selection criteria. These were checked on the basis of the self-presentations on the institutions' websites. The following two categories are distinguished:

1. Interdisciplinary institutes of digitalization research

- Comprehensive basic research on the digitalization of society as the central theme of the entire institute or center
- Broad interdisciplinarity: at least three disciplines; or two from different main disciplines or departments besides computer science (e.g. law and social sciences)
- Long-term established (or planned) institutes
- Visible knowledge transfer activities

2. Research focus: law and ethics

- Interdisciplinary institutions with a basic research focus on law and ethics as core disciplines and at least one other discipline
- Digitalization and its consequences must be the central theme of the research institution
- Recognizable as a self-contained institution (i.e., not a project of a department)
- Institutionalized for the medium to long term
