The workshop will focus on “**Smart Neighborhoods**” as key components of a smart, digitalized city.

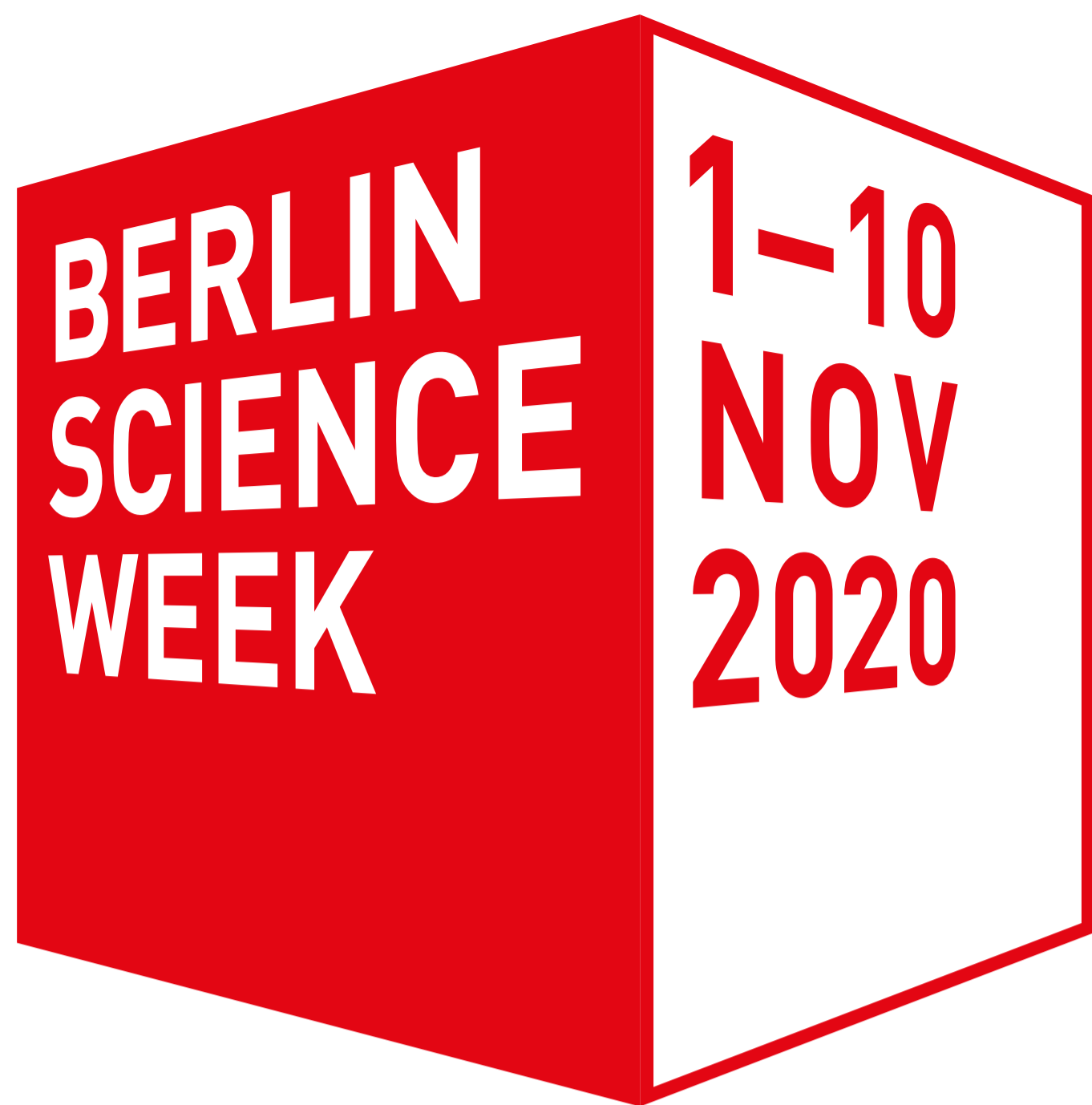
Smart Neighborhoods are the cross-scale elements connecting the small scale of individual buildings with the large scale of infrastructural, social, technological and environmental urban networks.

The digital transformation and sustainability of our urban neighborhoods and their communities will be analyzed and discussed from various angles, with the goal of identifying current research priorities, interdisciplinary challenges, and opportunities for joint collaboration between scientists and policy makers.

This workshop will provide an active forum to discuss the following main areas of interest related to Smart Neighborhoods:

- // **infrastructure** systems (e.g., district heating, mobility networks, interconnected water-energy infrastructure),
- // **technology** (e.g., smart metering, IoT sensors),
- // **sustainability** (e.g., sustainable consumption, environmental awareness),
- // **social challenges** (e.g., accessibility, equality, privacy), and
- // **governance** (e.g., data governance, data ownership, political agenda).

The Workshop will be hosted by **ECDF Professors Andrea Cominola (Smart Water Networks) and Tilman Santarius (Socio-Ecological Transformation and Sustainable Digitalization)**.
